As part of our global expansion strategy, Seacorp has recently secured an exclusive long term contract with a major iron ore exporter in Sierra Leone and are looking for suitably qualified Master Mariners to undertake a variety of marine surveys.

As the surveys will take place at anchorage off Freetown on Capesize vessels the successful applicant must be in good physical condition.

This is not an oil and gas position and sailing experience on dry bulk carriers will be a distinct advantage. The position available will be located in or around Freetown, Sierra Leone.

The requirements and duties for the positions are as follows:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum of one (1) year sea-going experience sailing on dry bulk carriers in the capacity of 3rd Officer or above.

EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

- A thorough knowledge of undertaking dry bulk survey work comprising of hold cleanliness surveys and draft surveys.
- A thorough knowledge and understanding of reviewing loading / de-ballasting plans.
- Previous experience in undertaking on/off-hire bunker and condition surveys is preferred but not essential.

PRE-REQUISITES

- Excellent communication skills in English (both oral and written).
- Excellent organizational and time management skills.
- Strong interpersonal and good negotiation skills.
- Honesty, reliability and loyalty to the company.
- Computer literate including Word and Excel programmes.
- Understandably the shipping industry is a 24/7 industry and therefore work outside normal hours will be required.
- Possess good initiative and a "can do" attitude.
- Be physically fit and in good health.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Undertaking of hold cleanliness surveys at anchorage or alongside a berth.
- Issuance of the hold cleanliness certificate on the company's standard format.
- Undertaking of the initial, intermediate (90% of the loaded figure onboard) and final draft surveys at anchorage or alongside a berth.
- Issuance of the final draft survey report and Certificate of Weight on the company's standard format.
- Review the loading / de-ballasting plans received from the ship's Captain to consider recommendations to improve loading efficiencies whilst taking into consideration safety parameters.
- If qualified, the following additional surveys to be undertaken if required;-
 - on/off-hire bunker survey
 - on/off condition survey
- In times of alleged damage between the transshipment vessel and the Ocean Going Vessel, including during the stevedoring process, the preparation of an independent report plus photographs of the alleged damage will be required.
- Assist the Shipping Agent with the preparation of cargo documents onboard the vessel such as the Statement of Fact, Notice of Readiness and Cargo Manifest etc on the company's format if required.
- Provide expertise and co-operation on any maritime associated matter as and when required

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Additional requirements of the position include:

- The ability to work unsupervised.
- The ability to work in a team environment.
- The ability to accept orders from supervisors and peers with regard to working schedules.
- Act within the explicit authorities given by Principals and the company.
- Ensure that all Principals are provided with the highest level of professional service at all times.
